"Children of Europe - Harmony Through Music"

Project introduction:

The "Children of Europe: Harmony Through Music" project aims to integrate Polish and Ukrainian children, especially military refugees, by organizing an all-Ukrainian vocal music competition in various regions of Poland. Music, as a universal language, can act as a bridge between cultures, helping children better understand each other, build friendships and collaborate on creative projects.

Project goals:

- *Cultural integration:*

Creating conditions for better understanding and respect between Polish and Ukrainian children. Development of cultural awareness and promotion of acceptance of cultural differences.

- *Psychosocial support:*

Providing a platform where war refugee children can find emotional support. Creating a sense of belonging and community, which is important in the adaptation process.

- *Art education:*

Promotion of vocal talents among children, development of their vocal and artistic skills. Supporting artistic education as a tool for expressing emotions and experiences.

- *Promotion of dialogue and cooperation:*

Creating opportunities for joint activities by participating in a vocal competition. Creating an atmosphere of mutual respect, cooperation and friendship between participants.

- *Counteracting stereotypes:*

Activities aimed at overcoming stereotypes and prejudices by co-creating and staging works of art.

Project stages:

- *Recruitment and training:*

Encouraging children to participate in the competition through cooperation with educational institutions, refugee aid centers and socio-cultural organizations. Organization of vocal and integration master classes for participants.

- *Regional selections:*

Conducting vocal competitions at the regional level in various parts of Poland. A selection of the best songs and performers who will advance to the national stage.

- *National final:*

Organization of the grand finale of the vocal competition, in which the winners of regional selections will compete. Providing professional musical accompaniment and stage production.

- *Related events:*

Organization of additional cultural events, performances, workshops and meetings expanding the scope of integration and understanding.

- *Promotion and tracking of successes:*

Active promotion of the event both locally and globally to draw attention to the initiative. Monitoring the success of participants after the competition, supporting their further artistic and integration development.

The "Children of Europe: Harmony Through Music" project has the potential not only to bring Polish and Ukrainian children closer together, but also to inspire other countries and communities to use art as a tool to build bridges between different cultures.
